

INFORMATION CLAUSE

If you purchase services from us through <https://lifearchitect.com>, we process your personal data that we receive from the site owner. Pursuant to Article 14 of regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC ("GDPR"), we hereby inform you that:

Purpose and legal basis for processing	<p>Your personal data is processed for the purpose of performance of the contract of sale of services concluded through https://lifearchitect.com. Personal data may also be processed by the Data Controller in order to establish, enforce or defend against legal claims, which is a legitimate interest of the Data Controller.</p> <p>Depending on the stage of the performance of the service, we may process different types and categories of personal data on different legal bases:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Conclusion and execution of a contract on purchase of services - section 6(1)(b) of GDPR and art. 6(1)(f) of GDPR to the extent that we use online tools to provide the service; 2. Any information you provide when the service is performed - art. 6(1)(a) of GDPR and art. 9(2)(a) of GDPR; 3. The Data Controller's fulfillment of its obligations under the law - art. 6(1)(c) of GDPR; 4. Establishing, asserting or defending against claims related to the processing of your personal data - art. 6(1)(f) of GDPR to the extent that the processing is necessary for the Data Controller's legitimate interest in establishing, asserting or defending against claims.
Data source	<p>The Data Controller processes personal data received from the owner of https://lifearchitect.com where we sell our services as market place seller. We also process data directly provided by you in connection with the provision of the service.</p>
Data sharing	<p>Your personal data of regular category may be shared with employees and contractors of the Data Controller who will be involved in the process of providing the service, as well as with service providers, including IT services, subject to data protection regulations. Personal data may also be shared with entities authorized by law.</p> <p>As a general rule, your personal data will not be transferred to a third country or an international organization that may provide a level of protection lower than that guaranteed by the provisions of GDPR, but if necessary, this will be done through appropriate legal mechanisms such as a Commission implementing decision, standard contractual clauses or other similar legal instruments provided by GDPR.</p>
Processing period	<p>Your personal data will be kept for the period necessary for the performance of the service. In the case of any personal data provided on the basis of your consent, processing will be carried out for the period necessary for the performance of the service, but no longer than until you withdraw your consent, with the stipulation that withdrawal of consent does not affect the legality of processing activities performed on the basis of consent before its withdrawal.</p>

	In any case, your personal data of regular category may be processed until the statute of limitations for potential legal claims - if there is a risk of such claims arising.
Your rights	<p>You have the right to require the Data Controller to access, rectify, erase or restrict your personal data, as well as the right to object to processing and the right to data portability. However, these rights may be limited by a specific provision of applicable law.</p> <p>You also have the right to withdraw your consent to processing at any time. Withdrawal of consent does not affect the lawfulness of processing activities carried out on the basis of consent before its withdrawal.</p> <p>You have the right to lodge a complaint with an authorized authority if you consider that the processing of your personal data violates the provisions of the data protection law.</p>
Necessity to provide data	Provision of any data at any stage of the service is voluntary, but may be necessary for the purpose of providing this service by the Data Controller.
Automated data processing and special categories of personal data	<p>Your personal data will not be subject to automated decision-making, including profiling.</p> <p>The Data Controller will not process special categories of personal data.</p>
